For a course in Bacteriology she had enrolled in the College of Physicians and Surgeons, Columbia University, women being admitted that year (in 1917) for the first time. She was soon made partial assistant in Bacteriology, then became permanent Research Assistant in Bio-Chemistry and a member of the faculty, where her grounding in Math was invaluable.

In 1932 she was invited to teach in the Guggenheim Dental School for Hygienists as head of the basic Sciences Dept. and went on to even greater achievements as Director of Research.

In reviewing our Class columns in the Barnard Alumnae Magazine, one finds, in almost every quarter, news of honors that have poured in upon Frances. She has endless citations: 60 years of membership in the American Chemical Society and 30 years of abstracting for the Chemical Abstracts. In 1974 The Jewish Theological Seminary of America awarded her a Doctor of Letters honoris causa. Her contribution to the American Jewish Community and Israel needs special and detailed evaluation.

Frances loves Barnard for its standards, its wisdom, its nurture, for giving her the mathematical and scientific undergirding that has made possible her great achievements. She is endlessly grateful to the College and its people.

## FRANCES KRASNOW THAU AND BARNARD COLLEGE

Frances Krasnow Thau became president of our Class, Barnard 1917, ten years ago, and gladdened us all by her imaginative and thoughtful handling of our every class need. For me, and many others, she appeared as a newly-discovered comet. Her college years had been so tightly planned that except by those who shared her classes, she was seldom seen. Now, as president she has quickly bound the class together, with frequent letters and detailed planning for annual reunions, other gatherings in between — even fund-raising. She says she is happy to be returning a bit of what Barnard gave her. I have scanned the records to learn what this may mean.

Frances was outstanding in High School, excelling in Mathematics and Science and finishing five years of credits during her four-year course. This won her a full-time scholarship in any college of her choice. She chose Barnard because of its distinguished faculty and its widely praised Departments of Mathematics and Science.

Entering Barnard, she found a keen awareness of human values, a nurturing atmosphere, with the unwavering goal of helping students to rise to their full potentials. Insatiable herself, she saw that Barnard offered all that she could absorb. She took every science course that was given, with all their endless laboratory hours. She swept through the sciences, getting honors in each one. She was active in the Math club. In her senior year she studied Greek to become familiar with the Greek symbols in Mathematics. In her four-year course she earned a Barnard B.S. in Mathematics and graduated magna cum laude, with a phi beta kappa key. She received a Columbia M.S. in Biology and in 1922 she received a Ph.D. from Columbia University.

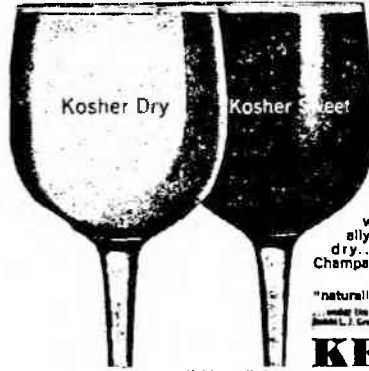
